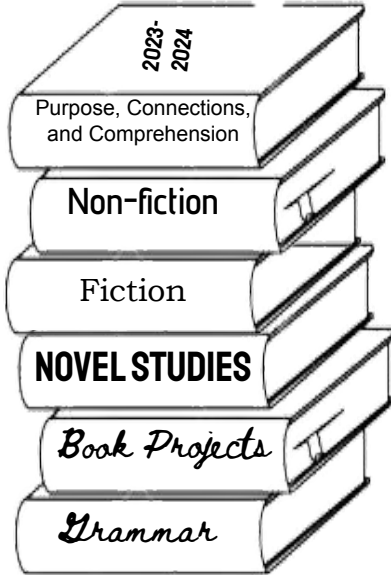


5th Grade English Language Arts

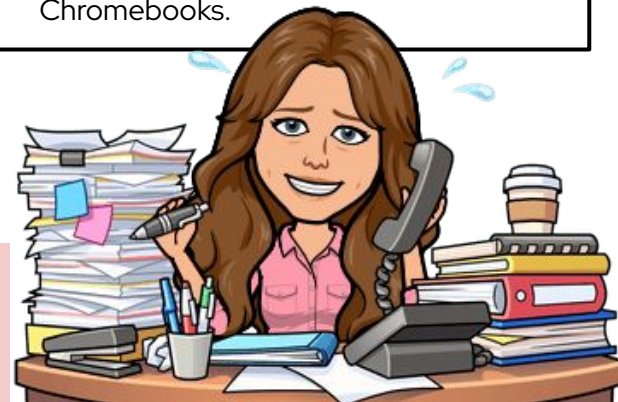

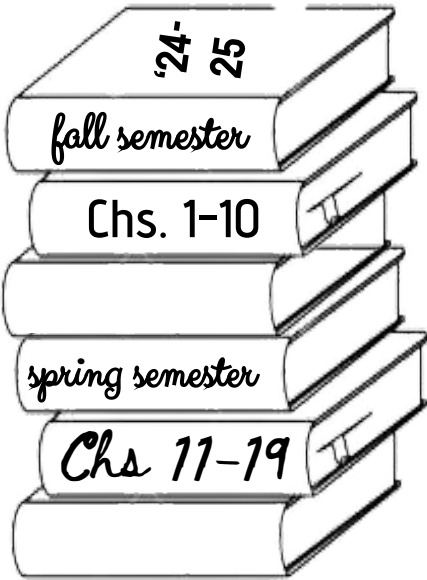

This year we will be exploring and enriching math concepts of place value, decimals, fractions, measurement and conversions, algebra skills, graphs and interpreting data, and volume using the four math operations of addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division.
